**SUMMER LANGUAGE ABROAD GRANT PROGRAM**

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**COMMITMENT TO FUTURE LANGUAGE COURSEWORK**

The Summer Language Abroad (SLA) Grant Program aims to advance language acquisition through intensive study abroad and a commitment to continued foreign language coursework afterwards. This commitment to additional foreign language coursework is intended to provide a bridge between the immersive language learning experience abroad and academic language study upon return to the Notre Dame campus.

All SLA Grant recipients are required to commit to at least one additional foreign language course of three to six credit hours in the semester **immediately following** their summer language abroad study.\* This course must be taken in the same language of study as your SLA Grant and provide both academic credit and an A-F letter grade.
